Standard 1

A school administrator is an educational leader who promotes the success of all students by facilitating the development, articulation, implementation, and stewardship of a vision of learning that is shared and supported by the school community.

Knowledge

The administrator has knowledge and understanding of the principles of developing and implementing strategic plans.

Disposition

The administrator believes in, values, and is committed to a school vision of high standards of learning, the inclusion of all members of the school community, and a willingness to continuously examine one's own assumptions, beliefs, and practices.

Issue

You have been asked by your superintendent to chair the committee which will revisit and ultimately rewrite the district's vision statement. You are also responsible for organizing the committee rewriting the mission statement for your own school.

Assignment

Identify the groups and individuals, the information sources, and collection and analysis of data strategies you will use.

Indicate how and to whom you will communicate the results.

Address the resources needed and where and how they will be obtained.
